


Figure 1. Forward Current Derating Curve




Figure 3. Typical Reverse Characteristics




Figure 5. Typical Junction Capacitance





Figure 2.Maximum Non-Repetitive Peak Forward Surge Current




Instantaneous Forward Voltage (V)


